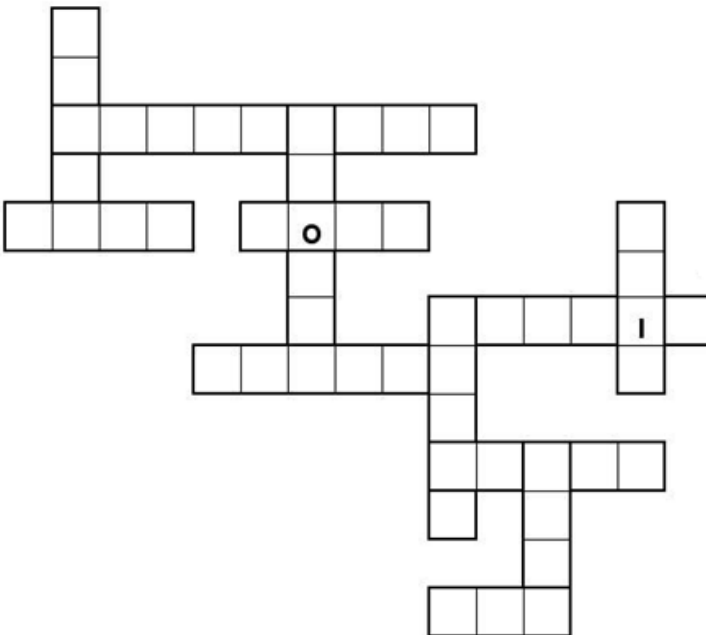
### Jesus raises the widow's son
