The Giving Machine

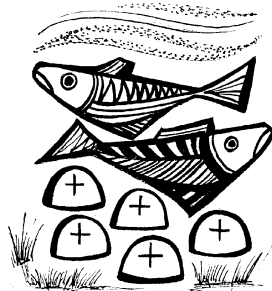
