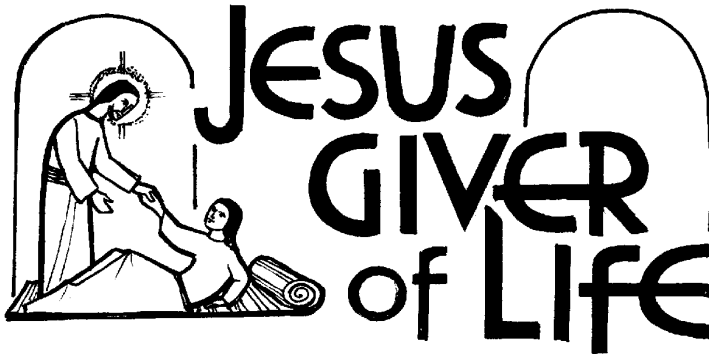

All children are welcome to join us in St. Theresa's room this Sunday, **1st July**.



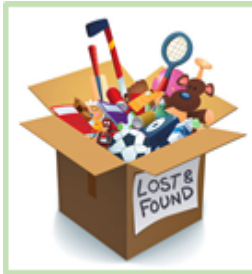
