

First Holy Communion 2018-2019

Your child will need to be a practising Catholic in Year 3 or above, (from September 2018), and have regularly attended Mass in St. Theresa's. (at least one year, unless you have moved into the Parish recently). We will be having an essential administration meeting with the new group and parents straight after the 10:00am. Mass on Sunday **1st July** in St. Theresa's room.
