your child to be registered for the First Holy Communion programme commencing June 2019, please fill out the form at the back of the church and give /post it to Father John as soon as possible but no later than noon, Sunday <u>23<sup>rd</sup> June</u>. (Late registration will mean your child will be registered for the 2020-

2021 group). Your child will need to be a practising Catholic in Year 3 or above, (from September 2019), and have regularly attended Mass in St. Theresa's. (at least one year, unless you have moved into the Parish recently and have a letter of practice from your Parish Priest). We will be having our first meeting with the new group and parents straight after the 10:00am. Mass on Sunday <u>**30**<sup>th</sup> June</u> in St. Theresa's room. Please note that if a sufficient number of Parish children are not registered, the course may not go ahead for this year.
